DESCENDANTS OF MOSES(2)HAYS - THIRD GENERATION

b1760

1. THOMAS(3)HAYS(MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b.Oct.5, 1784 in Greenwich Twp.,Sussex Co.,N.J. (now Warren Co.) Moved with parents to Smith Twp, Washington Co.,Pa. about 1785. m.1810, Jane Hayes of Beaver Co., Pa.(b.Apr.19, 1783 - d. May 19, 1842). They lived in Smith Twp. in 1810 but lived in Hanover Twp. in 1820. They moved to Scioto Twp., Jackson Co.,Ohio in 1837 or 1838. He lived there with son, Wm., in 1850. He died Apr.11, 1859, Jackson Co.,O. Both are buried in Buckeye Cem. south of Jackson,O. 4 ch.
2. EDITH(3)HAYS(MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b.Feb.27,1786, Smith Twp., Washington Co.,Pa. m.David Hays, Jr.of Cross Creek Twp.(b.1785, Cross Creek Twp.,Washington Co.,Pa. - d.May 29, 1869, age 83 yrs., 11 mos., 3 days at ~~Homer, Champaign Co.,Ill or at Fairmount or Fithian in Vermillion Co.,Ill.~~) They lived in Smith Twp., Washington Co.,Pa. in 1810 and 1830 but in Cross Creek Twp. in 1820. After 1830, they moved to Guernsey Co.,Ohio for 3 years. Before 1840, they settled near McArthur, O. which was then in Athens Co., and in 1850 became Vinton Co. They had nine sons and probably only one daughter. Four of their sons were baptized at Cross Creek Presbyterian Church, Washington Co.,Pa. 1818-1831. She d. Oct. 30, 1845, McArthur, Ohio and is buried there at Colvin Cemetery. He remarried and in 1850 lived at McArthur with his second wife, Eleanor. He was of Champaign Co.Ill. when he sold his land in Elk Twp., Vinton Co.Ohio in June 1857. He is in the 1860 census of Illinois twice. In June he was living with his daughter near Fairmount, Vermillion Co.,Ill. and in August he was living with his youngest son near Homer, Champaign Co. He is buried with his oldest son in McFarland Cem., 1½ mi. south of Muncie, Vermillion Co.,Ill.
3. JOHN(3)HAYS(MOSES 2, DAVID 1)b.Feb.23,1789, Smith Twp., Washington Co.,Pa. m. abt. 1816, Hannah _____(b.abt.1793 in Pa.) They lived in Smith Twp. in 1820 and 1830. They moved to Moorefield Twp., Harrison Co.,Ohio abt. 1834. He d. Feb. 20,1842 at Moorefield. and she d. June 10,1855, aged 60 yrs.,1 mo., 18 days. Both are buried in Nottingham Presbyterian Graveyard near Moorefield. All eight of their children were baptized Dec. 1833 at Cross Creek Presb. Church, Cross Creek, Pa. He was a blacksmith.
4. WILLIAM(3)HAYS(MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b.April 7, 1791, Smith Twp., Washington Co.,Pa. Unmarried. Killed by a cut from a scythe, July 8, 1821. Buried Cross Creek Presb. Graveyard.
5. JAMES(3)HAYS(MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b.June 11, 1793, Smith Twp., Washington Co.,Pa. m.March 28, 1815, Grace Ann Vail(b.March 25,1789 - d. July 15,1871). Lived So. Fayette Twp.,Allegheny Co.,Pa. in 1850 and 1860. He d. at Hays Crossing(now Iffley), Allegheny Co.,Pa. on July 23,1873. Seven children.
6. ALEXANDER(3)HAYS(MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b.Nov.11, 1795, Smith Twp.,Washington Co.,Pa. m. in 1824, Ann Vance Stevenson(b.Oct.14,1802 in Pa. - d. Apr.26,1881 - dau. of James and Ann Vance Stevenson). They lived 1½ mi. west of Burgettstown on the Stevenson farm in Smith Twp. Four children. He d. Sept.19 or 20,1846 and is buried in Cross Creek Presb. Graveyard.
7. MARY(3)HAYS(MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b.Dec.21, 1797, Smith Twp., Washington Co.,Pa. Died before 1800.
8. ELEANOR(3)HAYS(MOSES 2, DAVID 1)b.Nov.25,1799, Smith Twp., Washington Co.,Pa. m. after 1820, James Todd. He was one of the "forty niners" and died on the way home. After his death, she lived in a log house on the farm of her nephew, Wm. Vance Hays near Imperial, Pa. She was called"Nettie". She d. Feb. 19, 1876. Buried Cross Creek Presb. Graveyard. No children.

9. JOSEPH(3)HAYS (MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b. Feb. 15, 1801, Smith Twp., Washington Co., Pa. In 1837 he inherited the farm of his father, Moses Hays. m. abt. 1844, Eleanor Kerr (Dau. of Wm. & Eleanor Lyle Kerr). They lived on the inherited farm in Smith Twp. It was called "Cherry Valley Homestead". He d. Feb. 7, 1882. Six children.

10. DAVID(3)HAYS (MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b. May 7, 1803, Smith Twp., Washington Co., Pa. m. abt. 1837, Martha B. Fulton (d. Aug. 16, 1877 in 67th yr. of age - dau. of John and Jane Lockhard Fulton of Hanover Twp., Washington Co.). He was a farmer in Smith Twp. After his death on Jan. 19, 1847, she moved with their four children to Hanover Twp. United Presbyterian. Both are buried at Cross Creek Graveyard.

11. ANN(3)HAYS (MOSES 2, DAVID 1) b. June 23, 1805, Smith Twp., Washington Co., Pa. Died before 1810.
