

APPLICATIONS OF ANDREW(2)HAYS FOR BOUNTY LAND

State of Ohio Champaign County

On this Thirtieth day of October A.D. one thousand eight hundred and Fifty personally appeared before me, William C. Keller a justice of the peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, Andrew Hays aged Eighty Two years, a resident of Champaign County in the State of Ohio who being duly sworn according to law declares, that he is the identical Andrew Hays who was a private in the company commanded by Capt. Nicholas Cunningham in the First Regt. of Ohio Vols. commanded by Col. Duncan McArthur in the war with Great Britain declared by the United States on the 18th day of June 1812, that he volunteered at Fayette County Ohio, and _____ at Dayton Ohio on or about the first of May A.D. 1812, for the term of Six months, and continued in actual Service in said war untill surrendered at Detroit Michigan by General Hull on or about the 16th day of August A.D. 1812 - which will appear by the muster roll of said company. that he never received any discharge and remained a prisoner on parole untill exchanged or untill the close of the war as he has no recollection of receiving notice of exchange - he thinks he drew pay for Nine months Service-

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he may be entitled under the "act granting bounty land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States" passed September 28th, 1850 -

On this 2d Day of april 1855 before me a Justice of the Peace in and for the County and State aforesaid personally appeared Andrew Hayse aged 88 years who being duly Sworn According to Law declares that he is the Identical person who was A Private in the company commanded by Captain Nicholas Cunningham in the 1st Regiment of volunteers commanded by Col Duncan McArthur that he was taken prisoner at the Surrender of Detroit by General Hull on or about the 16th day of August 1812

He further states that he has received for said service Bounty Land warrant No. _____ of 80 acres issued under the act of 1850 which he has since Legally disposed of and cannot now return he makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the additional bounty Land to which he is entitled under the Act of March 3d 1855 never having received Bounty Land except as above stated and he hereby constitutes and appoints Charles C. Tucker of Washington D.C. his Attorney to prosecute his claim and procure his warrant. hereby authorizing and empowering his said Attorney to obtain from the proper authorities at Washungton City or elsware Certified Copies of any Army records or documents and all other evidence that may be necessary to establish his claim as fully as he might or could do if personally present and revoking and Countermanding all other authority that may have been given for the above specifide purpose

Sworn to and subscribed and Acknowledged before me the Day and Year first above written and on the same Day personally came before me Jacob Yambra and Joseph C. Brand residents of Urbana to me Known as Credible witnesses who being Duly sworn

according to Law declared that they are personally acquainted with Andrew Hayse who has made and subscribed the foregoing declaration that they were present and saw him subscribe to said declaration and that from their personal acquaintance with him they believe that he is the Identical person who performed the Military service therein named and who has received a warrant therefore and thay further swear that they are Disinterested in his claim.
